In the 2021/22 school year, classes were held both in person and online. We were provided mobile phones and laptops for the different classes.




Throughout the closing period of the schools, after-school classes have always provided help alongside the academic ones.

From the first year of the lower high school to the last of high school, guests attended a private after-school program in Vellanad. From fourth grade to eighth grade, however, 3 teachers conducted classes every day from 6 to 8 p.m., either in the library or in a family.

From first to third grade, the pupils received support from the older students or by the educator.

CHILDREN GUESTS OF THE FAMILY HOMES




The family homes in Vellanad, in the state of Kerala, currently host 61 girls and 36 boys. Although there have been several waves of Covid, they have never suspended their activities. The family homes consists of **3 facilities for females** and **1 for males**.

The staff of each home consists of an educator or an educator and a helper.



THE SCHOOL AND THE FINAL EXAMS

This year, 6 girls and 5 boys had the SSLC exam (high school graduation), which began on March 31. Instead, they are preparing for the last year of secondary high school final exam: 4 girls and 1 boy in humanities, 1 boy in computer science and 1 boy in journalism. For all others, except those in the first year of secondary high school, the exam started on March 23 and finished on April 2.



SPORTS AND MUSIC


Practice of volleyball were used to take place on Saturdays, on Sundays or during vacations, in the morning or in the evening. The girls on the volleyball team have gone through selections and were chosen by several teams.

Dance classes were held on Sunday from 9 to 11 a.m. The class are enrolled about 24 girls.

Music classes are regularly on Sundays, from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m., attended the course about 19 among boys and girls.

Violin lessons, take place on Saturday evening, from 5 to 7 p.m.





THE LIBRARY: A RESOURCE

In the library, in addition to the existing 850 books, in the year 2021 about 200 more were purchased, **for a total of about 1,050 volumes.** The library is well organized with tables and chairs for reading. There is also a TV and a blackboard for possible seminars and meetings. During school time, the hours are from 5 to 6 p.m. or otherwise from 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. At other times, guests have freedom of access for school research or note-taking. A register is kept to mark the dates of book loans. Throughout the lockdown, the library has played a key role to effective use of time. Books helped get through that long period of lockdown well.



EQUIPMENT

The 4 family homes are equipped with television, a washing machine and other appliances.
